

General Rules/Information for Hog and Javelina Hunters

Arrival & Departure:

- Please plan to arrive after 11:00AM and before dark the day of your hunt.
- Text or call me when you hit the gravel road since I may be out baiting
- Check-in at lodge for signing liability release, orientation and final payment
- We ask that on your last day, clear your room, refrigerator, and food shelf off by 10:00AM and depart by 11:AM so that I may clean it for the next group.

Pasture and Baits:

- First Javelina is included in hunt, \$125 for 2nd
- Draw blood=kill
- You may only hunt the baits I assign
- No driving all over the pasture at night. Report to your bait and return to the HQ whenever you want.
- Do not add anything to the bait location. i.e. Extra corn around the bait will spook them.
- Leave barrels as you found them so I know if they've been hit.
- You may move any tripods around the bait but do not move to another bait without asking.
- Do not shoot hogs or javelina and not recover. Make a serious effort to find you game.
- Please place gut bucket in cooler because dogs will get into it.
- All javelina need to be recorded with hunter's name, address and license number.
- Do not set up on property line because your animal will go across. Never fails.
- You may take a firearm in the pasture. Do not wear it around camp.
- Report any illegal alien activity
- Hunters are responsible for their own transportation to and from the pasture. It is advisable to bring tire sealer and plugs, extra fuel if staying for an extended time.
- Please respect artifacts, like arrowheads and petrified wood, and leave them on the ground

Camp:

- Hunters are responsible for their own sheets, pillows, towels, and food
- A kitchen complete with pots/pans, stove, microwave and coffee pots are there for you to use, as well as BBQ pits. Bring trash liners to put you game in. I have a Keurig coffee machine.
- Please be considerate of other groups and keep kitchen clean, wash your dishes and put up!
- Keep food, coffee pots and coolers out of room because they may leak.
- #1 rule. Please don't feed Joule or Spicedog
- Butt cans are furnished. DO NOT THROW BUTTS ON THE GROUND.
- Bathrooms are in your rooms. NOT OUTSIDE because there may be women around
- I've got a bunch of lost tripods that weren't returned! If you see one out there, flag it, and let me know

No hunt-day money refunded if you leave early. I reserve the right to send you packing if you don't respect my rules. Thanks, and good luck on your hunt.

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
