## Hog and Javelina Information

### Welcome to the Lincoln Ranch

Check-in is @ 11:00 AM. If you are planning to arrive later than that please call or text me @ 830-459-2280

On arrival day let me know either by calling or text when you plan to arrive since I may be out baiting.

Please park in the parking lot outside the 2-story lodge one of us will check you in. After orientation, your group will be assigned a pasture.

- We furnish corn at the Ranch at a higher price but you may bring your own. Any convenience or grocery store along the way has corn.
- You hunt Javelina during the day by corning the roads (senderos) and spot and stalk or brush-in and wait for them to pass by.
- I run a feed route for javelina on designated senderos only. Bring corn to do your own javelina baiting. I
- Hogs are hunted day and night either over baits or by corning the roads and set up on them.
- We furnish a lighted bait for hog-hunting
- State limit is 2 javelina, however you are allowed one javelina free and second is \$125. They may ONLY be hunted during legal daylight shooting hours.
- You are allowed unlimited hogs. No more than you want to find and take care of. Do not shoot and let lay.
- State License is required.

- You furnish your own transportation to and from pastures. 4-Wheelers are allowed and you might want to bring some tire plugs, Gerry cans of gas and sealer for your vehicle.
- Make sure you fill up before you come. The last gas stations before you get to the ranch are in Encinal or in Freer....or in Laredo if you are there.

#### Things to bring that most people forget:

- 1) Reminder: Gerry cans of gas if you're staying a while
- 2) Loppers or saw for making brush blinds or brushing in
- 3) Machete, gloves, short rope to hack your way through thorns to find your animal
- 4) Rubber boots
- 5) Garbage bags to put your meat in

- 6) Towel, pillow, sleeping bag
- 7) Comfortable chair for sitting and stalking
- 8) \$5 bills for 20# bags of ice. Washer/dryer \$10
- 9) Thermocell, Bug spray, sunscreen
- 10) Small camp shovel for burying toilet paper

I sell a few things in my gift shop:

- caps
- T-shirts long and short sleeved. Camo and plain. GameGuard
- Loppers and machetes
- Thermocells and refills
- Tweezers
- Broadheads
- Bow lights for hog hunting

Some of the things I furnish:

1. Toilet paper
2. Pots and pans
3. Dishwashing soap
4. Dish towels
5. Wood for bbq pit
6. Soured corn for the hog baits
